Your Arrival

You will find various equipment and amenities provided in your mobile home. These items are carefully checked before your arrival. If anything is missing, broken, or not functioning properly, please let us know. We will address any issues during or after your stay, depending on the equipment.

Your Departure

Departure Instructions

Before leaving, please:

- Empty your trash and deposit it in the containers in the parking area.
- Wash and put away your dishes.
- Remove the coffee filter and rinse the coffee maker.
- Empty and clean the refrigerator (no food should be left inside).
- Set the thermostat to 2 or the minimum setting.
- Turn off the heating in your accommodation if it was used.
- Do not lock the door when leaving and return the keys to reception.
- Report any incidents (breakages, malfunctions, or anomalies) as soon as possible so we can address them promptly.

Linen Rental:

If you rented bed linen, please fold it, place it in the provided bag, and leave it in the accommodation.

 **Important:**

- Any neglected tidying will be charged €80.
- Any stained linen or mattresses will result in a €50 deduction from your deposit.

Community Living

Around Your Accommodation

- From 11:00 PM, please help us maintain peace and quiet on the site.
- No structures (tents, canopies, etc.) may be set up on the grounds.
- The use of Bluetooth speakers is allowed, but must not cause noise disturbance.
- Personal barbecues and picnics in dining areas are prohibited.
- Fires are strictly forbidden, except on the designated barbecue spots.
- The use of illegal drugs is strictly prohibited. Any violation will result in immediate eviction.
- Please do not modify or touch any facilities on the property without authorization.
- Do not enter restricted areas (marked by red-and-white chains and/or signs).

In Your Accommodation

- Deep-frying with oil is prohibited.
- Your trash must be emptied daily. Leaving bags or bottles in front of or under the accommodation is not allowed.
- The use of portable heaters or air conditioners is prohibited (fans are allowed).
- Please respect the inventory and do not move dishes or kitchenware between chalets.
- Do not use curtain rods to hang clothes.
- No items should be hung from the structure of the accommodation (hammocks, bags, etc.).
- Please do not add any accessories to your accommodation (hooks, bars, adhesives, etc.).
- Do not block ventilation openings.
- Do not flush anything down the toilets, especially wet wipes! Any blockage will incur repair costs charged to you.

We close the curtains and shutters at night to help keep your accommodation cozy.


